

Can I bring a portable power bank to Guinea-Bissau

When traveling by air, keeping your devices charged is essential. However, strict regulations govern the types of power banks you can bring onboard. Understanding these rules will help ensure your portable charger power bank doesn't get confiscated at security checkpoints.

Are power banks allowed in carry-on luggage?

However, the specific regulations regarding power banks may vary depending on the airline, the country you're traveling to, and the type and capacity of the power bank. According to the International Air Transport Association (IATA), power banks with a capacity of up to 100 watt-hours (Wh) are allowed in carry-on baggage.

Can you take a power bank through airport security?

You can take a power bank through airport security but you will have to remove it from your carry on bag and place it in a separate bin to go through the x-ray screening process. The TSA agent will check the capacity of the portable charger before it is allowed through. It must be within the TSA battery pack limits set out in the section below.

Can you put a power bank in a bag?

Avoid using a power bank inside a bag as it can overheat.
