


Costa Rica outdoor power supply is usable





Overview

Costa Rica operates on 120V voltage and 60Hz frequency, just like the U.S. and Canada. That means that any device you own that's rated for 120V should work just fine without a voltage converter. Devices rated for 127V will probably work, too.Do I need a power outlet in Costa Rica?

The two most important things to note with the power outlets in Costa Rica is that they are Type A and B. If you come from a country that uses these plug types, you will not need an adapter.

What power plugs and outlets are used in Costa Rica?

In Costa Rica, there are two types of power plugs and outlets: Type A and Type B. Both types are used in airports, hotels, restaurants, etc., but they differ in terms of shape. Type A: Type A plugs have two flat prongs on either side of the plug.

Do device plugs work in Costa Rica?

Most device plugs will work with the outlet types in Costa Rica. Also, the voltage in Costa Rica is the same as in North America. Please note: an adapter will be needed if your device plug has a grounding pin and you are trying to use a Type A outlet. For this reason, we always recommend traveling with a universal travel adapter.

Does Costa Rica use a plug a or B?

Costa Rica mainly uses plug types A and B for power outlets. Devices with electric Plug A fit both Plug A and B outlets, while Plug B devices are exclusive to B outlets. Costa Rica operates on a 120V voltage system and a 60Hz frequency. Travelers from regions using Plugs A or B do not need an adapter.

What types of outlets are available in Costa Rica?

Costa Rica outlets are plug types A and B. Devices with electric Plug A can fit in both Plug A and Plug B. Devices with Plug B can ONLY fit into Plug B



electrical outlets. Note: Some places we stayed in Costa Rica only had Plug A power outlets. In that case, our Plug B devices would have required an adapter.

Do you need an adapter to plug in a cable in Costa Rica?

Electrical sockets (outlets) in Costa Rica are like the electrical outlets found in Canada, Mexico, and the U.S. If your device has a North American plug, you probably won't require any adapter in order to plug in your cables and devices. There are two outlet variations that may require an adapter: grounding and polarization.
