Overview

What is a base services charge & a variable electricity delivery charge?

The new law (Assembly Bill 205) requires costs to be separated into a Base Services Charge to cover the cost of certain electrical equipment and services, and variable electricity delivery charges based on the electricity the customer uses during their billing period.

What is the difference between basic charge and base services charge?

The Basic Charge covers the cost of metering and billing. The Base Services Charge will replace that charge and now includes the cost of certain electrical equipment and services. What are the bill components included in the Base Services Charge?

Distribution, Public Purpose Program Charge, Nuclear Decommissioning, New system generation charge.

What charges are included in my electricity bill?

In addition to the base charges, your electricity bill may include: Energy Charges: The price per kWh charges applied by the electricity provider for the electricity consumed. TDU Delivery Fees or TDU Pass Through Charges: There are two. One is a price per kWh charge and the other is a flat monthly fee.

How much does the base services charge cost?

The Base Services Charge will be approximately \$24 per month for mastermetered customers and covers essential costs to maintain the infrastructure which keeps the property connected to the electric grid.

What are base charges?

Here are the basics of what you need to know. Base charges are fixed monthly fees imposed by electricity companies regardless of how much energy you consume. Review and compare Electricity Facts Labels to determine which



plans have or do not have base charges. What are base charges or base fees?


What is the difference between base charge and energy charge?

Base Charge – This fixed monthly fee covers basic operating costs for your electric provider. It applies regardless of your actual energy usage. Energy Charge – This charge is based on your electricity usage each month, measured in kilowatt-hours (kWh). The more energy you use, the higher this charge will be.

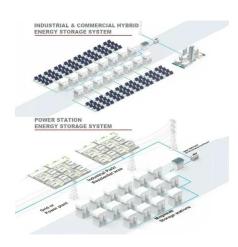
