Which Philippine military bases are EDCA sites?

In 2016, five Philippine military installations were designated as EDCA sites: Basa Air Base in Pampanga, Fort Magsaysay in Nueva Ecija, Antonio Bautista Air Base in Palawan, Mactan-Benito Ebuen Air Base in Cebu, and Lumbia Air Base in Cagayan de Oro.

Who visited enhanced defense cooperation agreement sites in the Philippines?

The Philippine delegation, led by Armed Forces of the Philippines Chief of Staff Andres Centino, visited the province's Enhanced Defense Cooperation Agreement sites, which are designated Philippine military bases, but allow U.S. access.

What does the new EDCA site in Balabac mean for US-Philippine security?

Ultimately, the established order of the new EDCA site in Balabac represents some other breakthrough inside the US-Philippine defense partnership, with each nation working collectively to address security challenges in the area.

How many EDCA sites are there in the Philippines?

The naming of these locations follows a February 2023 announcement in



which the United States and the Philippines committed to designate four new EDCA sites in strategic areas of the Philippines.

Can the US build military facilities in the Philippines?

Yes, the US can construct facilities and infrastructure at the agreed locations to support joint military activities and the storage of equipment and supplies. However, these facilities remain under the ownership and control of the Philippines. 5.

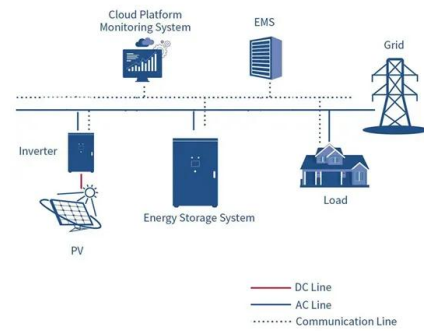
