Which radio station is the most popular in Congo?

While Radio Okapi is one of the leading stations in the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Radio France Internationale (RFI) is the most popular news station. RFI is widely available on FM and employs mostly-Congolese staff.

Is the Democratic Republic of the Congo lagging behind in telecommunications?

Compared to the United States, the Democratic Republic of the Congo is massively lagging behind in the development of telecommunications. Under the country code +243, there were a total of 49.86 million connections in 2023. Among them were 49.80 million mobile phones, which corresponds to an average of 0.49 per person.

Which telco operates in the Democratic Republic of Congo?

In DRC, Orange has more than 15 million subscribers, and more than 3,400 sites. South African-based Vodacom, which is a subsidiary of UK telco Vodafone, operates in several other African markets, including the Democratic Republic of Congo, Egypt, Ethiopia, Kenya, Lesotho, Mozambique, and Tanzania.

What is the telecommunications industry like in the DRC?

The telecommunications industry has not yet reached all potential consumers and has room to grow. Mobile telephones have a 44 percent penetration rate; internet penetration is approximately 3 percent of the total population. The DRC has not yet reached 5G and is still developing its 3G/4G network.

How many people in the Congo have broadband?

Values above 100 percent mean that, on average, every inhabitant has more than one connection. The Democratic Republic of the Congo is lagging behind in the expansion of broadband internet connections. Around 31 percent of all




residents have access to the internet.

How will the DRC telcos support a new solar-powered base station?

According to the telcos, the JV will extend network coverage for up to 19 million people in less densely populated rural areas of the DRC. To support the connectivity plans, the duo have pledged to jointly build up to 2,000 new solar-powered base stations over the next six years, which will provide 2G and 4G connectivity.




